Treasurer's Report – Jeff T motion/Heather M second/APPROVED

- 1. All bills and statements as of July 30 have been paid.
- 2. A 2018 prepaid income general journal entry was made for \$1,525.00.
- 3. July bank statements have been reconciled and registries are correct.
- 4. Total income for July was \$36,263.00, which exceeded expenditures of \$31,255.35 by \$5,007.65. Terrific for a summer month which also included the six-month Mission Support contributions. The total income did exceed the planned budget of \$34,639 by \$1,624.
- 5. Total income for the year of \$213,808, which, as of July 30, leaves us short of the budget goal by \$2,745. At this point of the summer that's acceptable and we are functioning well within our projected expenses.
- 6. The 2019 Portico Plan choice for staff should be approved in Sept.

7. Grinnel Insurance (Property) wants to re-evaluate the structural value of our building, which is currently valued at \$2.7M. They have quoted a value of \$1.6M, Bain Insurance and Paul Gurholt have indicated that it should be at least the \$2.7, maybe closer to \$3M. John Kraft did some extensive measuring to determine square footage, building type and structural materials in response to Grinnel. Council will decide to accept or request another opinion/estimate from another builder and/or contractor.

Congregational Operations

- 1. Building and Grounds Jeff Thomas
 - a. MGR is donating landscaping border, the same "curbing" that surround the playground. Measurements have been taken and work should be completed this fall.
 - b. Boulevard sign will be painted.
 - c. Idea has been proposed for a sitting area in front of the church, we will be getting some drawings soon.
 - d. Initiated discussion into our janitorial service and whether we need to move in a different direction. With our membership numbers going up and more activities taking place in the church, it might require increased maintenance.
- 2. Budget Committee Initial budget review will take place on October 6 at the Council Retreat.
- 3. Nominating Committee should consider meeting to review potential candidates for council, etc.

Congregational Life

- 1. Generosity Action Team Ken Will is working with a group to determine how we can improve our services, mission and stewardship.

- Jo Wilson, MGR, attended the weekly staff meeting and was asked how we could better support her mission. There were no specific issues, but we did discuss ways to work together, for example: volunteer opportunities, free library, food pantry and CPR/AED training.

- 4. Christian Education Should be ready for Church School and Confirmation
- 5. Congregational Nurturing
 - a. Continue summer picnics with youth activities and church service (need a banner).
 - b. Discussed various ways to volunteer in the community, some ideas are: Rebuilding Together and United Way "Day of Caring".
